



MICHAEL C HALL **'LAZARUS' SHOW REAWAKENS MEMORIES** OF DAVID BOWIE

It felt like a homecoming for the cast of Lazarus when the stage show transferred from New York to London last week. The musical features songs by late singer David Bowie, who wasn't far from the cast's thoughts – he had made his final public appearance at the Manhattan premiere last December, a month before his death.

Leading man Michael C Hall – who was joined by his wife Morgan Macgregor (left) on the first night of the show, in which he plays Thomas "Starman" Newton – said: "The experience of it tonight really brought back memories of the New York opening because that was the last time we all saw him."

His co-star Sophia Anne Caruso, 15, has special memories of meeting David when she auditioned for the musical, which is inspired by the book The Man Who Fell to Earth and which includes David's songs Changes, Hevoes and Life on Marx.
