MICHAEL C HALL 'LAZARUS' SHOW REAWAKENS MEMORIES OF DAVID BOWIE

It felt like a homecoming for the cast of *Lazarus* when the stage show transferred from New York to London last week. The musical features songs by late singer David Bowie, who wasn't far from the cast's thoughts – he had made his final public appearance at the Manhattan premiere last December, a month before his death.

Leading man Michael C Hall – who was joined by his wife Morgan Macgregor (left) on the first night of the show, in which he plays Thomas "Starman" Newton – said: "The experience of it tonight really brought back memories of the New York opening because that was the last time we all saw him."

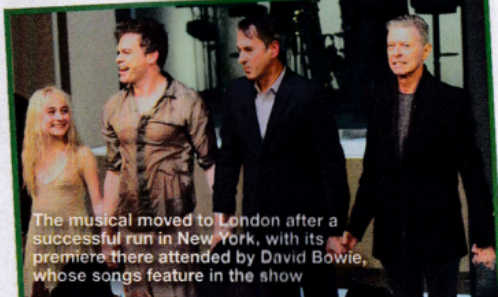
