I have actually planned a girlie spa night in a couple of weeks and I can't wait. But we always talk about our children, so I think we need to put some sort of ban on that while we're there! I love spending time with my girlfriends. We've got Justin's daughter staying with us for a few weeks, so it's been really nice to have another

woman in the house. I'm totally outnumbered and Bobby likes to tell me that!
