#### Farce of car smoking ban

POLICE could turn a blind eye to a controversial new law banning motorists from smoking when there are children in the car.

From tomorrow, officers will have the power to pull over anyone they suspect of smoking in a vehicle with anyone under 18.

Those caught are expected to be handed a £50 on-the-spot fine.

But Jayne Willetts, of the Police Federation, which represents frontline officers, said it "just creates an unnecessary extra layer

of bureaucracy". She added: "With resources being cut, no force can prioritise their hard-pressed police officers' time for this."
