



## Rebecca sings the Lady's blues

Single mum-of-three Rebecca Ferguson hasn't found her Prince Charming yet - and reckons it's because her love life is as "terrible" as that of tragic jazz singer Billie Holiday.

The former X Factor star, 28, has a new album, *Lady Sings The Blues*, in which she covers Billie's hits.

On stage at London's St James Theatre, she said: "These next few songs epitomise my terrible love life. I think Billie could relate too." Rebecca had third

child, daughter Arabella, last October but was dumped by the father soon after.

In *Lover Man*, she sings: "The night is cold and I'm so alone, I'd give my soul just to call you my own feel alone... got no one to love me, lover man where can you be?"

Tragic Billie worked as a prostitute and battled heroin addiction. She was also robbed by her own mother and friends before her death in 1959.
