## Follow the star... pupils sing carols with Pixie for penny campaign

PIXIE LOTT today backed Penny for London by singing Christmas carols with primary school children who will benefit from the charitable scheme.

The pop star and former *Strictly Come Dancing* contestant joined pupils from Islington's Copenhagen Primary School at St Pancras International station this morning to sing for commuters.

Penny for London is a world-first giving project: every time a registered user pays for a journey on London Transport with a contactless payment card, a "microdonation" of between 1p and 10p is donated to the Mayor's Fund for London.

The money will be given to groups helping disadvantaged young Londoners – with 10 per cent going to the Standard's Dispossessed Fund.

Lott, 23, who also sang her new single *Caravan of Love*, said: "I am delighted to be able to support this wonderful new charity scheme. It gives me great pleasure to be able to help those young people from deprived areas in the capital, especially at Christmas time.

"Penny for London makes donating to charity so quick and easy. And we can all afford to give one penny."
