A Not yet! We went to Japan and had people waiting for us at the airport which was unexpected.

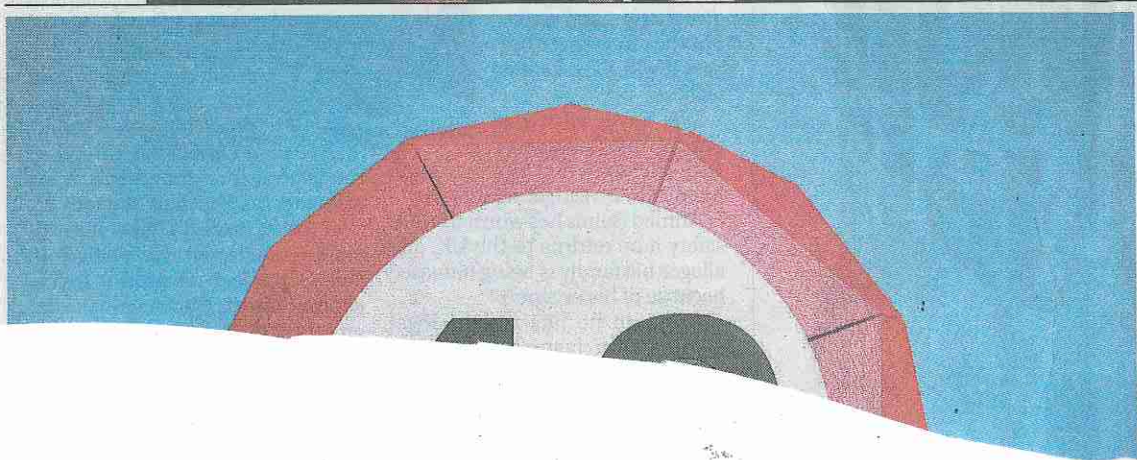
Q Album hopes?
