UK AIRPLAY ANALYSIS

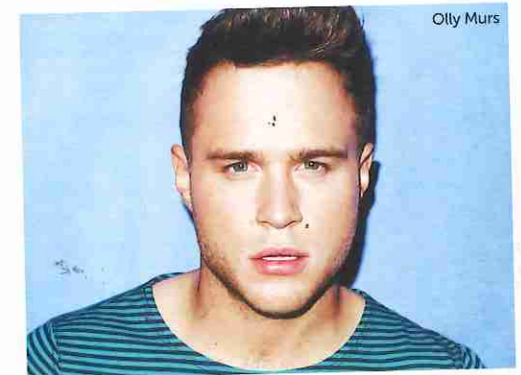
Knocked from its pedestal atop the OCC chart, Adele's Hello is in no mood to give up its radio airplay chart throne yet, and spends a fourth straight week atop the list with plays up again to a record 7,046 (from 7,019), although its audience shrinks 2.10% to 85.95m

It suffered slight declines at Radio 1 (from 25 to 23 plays) and Radio 2 (from 16 to 15 plays), but was aired 50 times or more on 14 stations, with top tallies of 63 plays on JACKfm2 and JACKfm2 Surrey, and 54 on Capital London, Capital South Wales and Capital North East.

Three tracks advance into the Top 10 of the radio airplay chart for the first time: **WSTRN's** In2, **Justin Bieber's** Sorry and **Fleur East's** Sax.

London trio **WSTRN's** debut hit, In2, climbed as high as No.4 on the OCC chart last week, and is receiving massive radio support. Jumping 11-5 on the radio airplay chart, it increased plays by 25.15% from 1,956 to 2,448, while upping its audience 12.21% from 39.63m to 44.47m. Its tally of 24 plays on Radio 1 is exceeded only by **Jamie Lawson's** Wasn't Expecting That (26 plays) and **The 1975's** Love Me (25 plays). Five Capital Network stations shared most-played honours on the track, each airing it 72 times.

Just six weeks after last single What Do You Mean peaked at No.3 on the radio airplay chart, follow-up Sorry sprints 16-6 for Justin Bieber. The new OCC No.1 achieves a massive 23.00% uplift in plays from 2,922 to 3,594, and an even

bigger 32.79% increase in audience, from 33.18m to 44.06m. Like In2, it tops out at 72 plays on five Capital Network stations. A chunky 22.26% of its audience comes from 18 plays at Radio 1 - twice the number of plays it received in the previous frame.
